Health Form & Payment: Must be received upon or before arrival. These can be completed through the online registration portal.

Contact with your Camper: We encourage you to make contact with your child via mail service to give encouragement and personal updates. This can be a meaningful way to relate during camp. This is our preference rather than contacting them via phone or email. We also invite parents to leave mail to be delivered by camp staff throughout the week, rather than use the postal service, which can be delayed. Make sure to address any mail left with Camp Staff at Check-In with the name of the camper and the day you hope it is delivered.

Camp Store: Most evenings, campers will have a time to purchase items in our camp store. Camp Store gift cards can be purchased at Check-In when you arrive. What they do not spend will not be returned to them at the end of the week, but will go towards scholarships for other campers in need.
