## Notes

**Kids Camp:** Childcare provided for ages 0-6. Sign-up for morning and/or afternoon sessions.

*Make sure to fill out an Info Sheet about your child.*

**Waterfront & Open Beach:** You are welcome to swim at your own risk or use our kayaks/canoes at our Main Beach or Lakeview Beach from 8:00am until dusk. Children **MUST** be accompanied by an adult. Everyone on a boat must wear a life jacket at all times.

**Activity Groups:** Check out what is offered, and sign-up in the Dining Hall. Please let us know if there is another activity you would like to see, and we will put it on the schedule! Children 6 & under should have an adult with them.

**Camp Store:** We can open Camp Store at any time, just ask someone in the office.

**Evening Free Time Options:** We encourage everyone to gather in the Dining Hall or by the campfires in the cabin areas for our evening activities. While we welcome a variety of ages, we also encourage adults to use this as a time without young children to make connections and gather.

- **Competitive Recreation:** Join us for a large group game for older kids (13+) and adults.
- **Card & Table Games:** Join us in the Dining Hall for a variety of games with your peers.

**Special Trips:** If there is an area attraction your family would like to visit, you are welcome to sign-up for a sack lunch to take with you on your self-guided trip. *Sack lunch sign-ups must be 24 hours in advance.*

Some suggested trips (with info on the table) are to Warren Dunes State Park, and Blueberry Picking.

**\*Polar Bears/ Flyers-** Jump into the lake for an early morning cool off (Polar Bears).

Go for a light run around camp (Flyers). Meet at the bell for both activities.

**\*Morning Watch-** Awaken to the new day watching for God's presence among us with singing and words from our pastor. Meet in the amphitheater.

**\*Morning Quest-** Join us for a fun, energy filled worship service where you will sing, see a skit, hear from the pastor and more. Meet in the amphitheater.

**\*Activity Groups-** Sign up for activities that you want to participate in and make sure to meet at the bell at the time of the activity. Each activity will last for approximately an hour so, be sure to join in at the beginning so you don't miss any of it. If you want to learn more about what each activity is, feel free to ask any staff member.

**\*Recreation-** Come ready to play a large group game! The game we are playing and location will be announced at dinner. People of all ages are welcome to join for recreation at 6:30pm.

**\*Campfire-** Join us for our evening time of worship up in Mosquito Hollow. Every evening there will be popcorn, songs, words from our pastor and more.
