

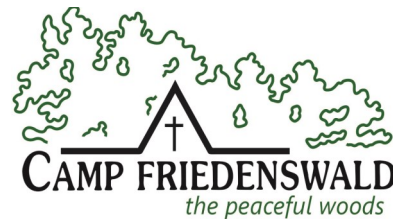
Summer Schedule

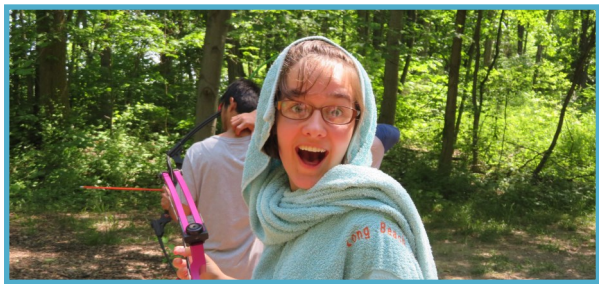

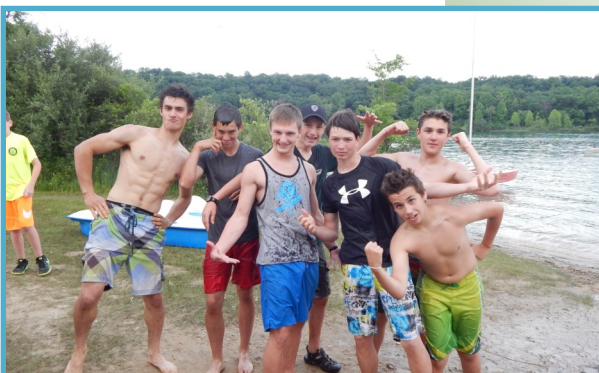
