

Healthy Camper Guidelines - COVID-19

In compliance with orders from the State of Michigan, and out of a desire to protect the health of camp staff and guests, we ask you to observe and commit to the following:

- Perform a health check before/during/after camp stay:
 - Stay home if you currently are experiencing, or have experienced, COVID-19 related symptoms in the past 10 days
 - Notify Camp staff if you begin to experience symptoms while at Camp (and be prepared to leave immediately)
 - Notify Camp staff (269-476-9744) if COVID-19 symptoms develop for you or someone in your group up to 10 days after leaving Camp
- Follow social distancing guidelines and maintain at least 6 feet distance from people outside your household
- Wear a face mask if/when interacting with someone from outside your household indoors
- Wash hands with soap and water frequently during your stay
- Abide by scheduled beach/activity times in order to allow for social distancing
- Communicate your concern of social distancing directly with other guests, if necessary

Camp Friedenswald's Commitment:

- Camp staff will observe social distancing when interacting with you and will wear a mask if/when interacting indoors
- Camp staff will thoroughly clean and disinfect high touch surfaces in your lodging before your arrival
- Shared indoor common spaces will remain closed (i.e. Dining Hall, Cottonwood Center, Nature Center)
- Shared outdoor spaces with high touch surfaces will be cleaned daily (i.e. playground swings; boating equipment; water ladders)
- Camp staff will be available (by radio) throughout your stay at Camp to address needs and concerns as they arise

General Guest Guidelines

- Respect other guests and Camp's facilities and grounds by replacing what you moved and cleaning what you dirtied.
- Please be mindful of the 3 R's (reduce, reuse, recycle) to help care for the earth during your stay.
- Please observe an all-camp quiet time of 12:00 midnight. After midnight please restrict activities to inside your cabin/lodge.
- All guests have equal access to general use areas.
 Exclusive or specific use is guaranteed by advance scheduling only.
- Please be aware that cell phone service is unreliable and WiFi is available outside the Dining Hall.
- Alcohol, pets, fireworks, and firearms are not permitted.
- Cigarette smoking is only permitted outside at designated areas where butt containers are located: Nature Center, Lakeview Lodge, and Cottonwood Center
- Bicycles, rollerblades, and skateboards are not permitted on Camp trails or walkways.
- Please adhere to additional policies posted throughout Camp property.

Beach Policies

- Open beach from 8:30 am to dusk (9 pm at the latest)
- Between 1-5 pm beach will be reserved for a select group of campers (North/South Cabin areas) to reduce total number of people at the beach at a given time.
- Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult over 18.
- Swim at your own risk. No lifeguard on duty.
- Children under 18 must wear the lifejacket when boating.
- Everyone must have a lifejacket with them when boating.
