Give a gift...

Friedenswald Fund...

... is used to help cover the costs of running year-round programming at Camp. Registration fees cover roughly 80% of annual expenses, which means Camp depends on the generous annual support of its Builders to cover the remaining 20%.

Endowment Fund...

...is used to supplement annual support of Camp's programs, camper scholarships, and facility improvements. Contributing to the Endowment Fund is investing in Camp's future and ensuring its long-term vitality. Investments are managed by Everence.
