



The following activities and courses are available to you and your family during your Winter Camp Getaway. Each one-hour session will be led by a knowledgeable Camp Friedenswald guide, Amy Huser or Skye McKinnell. Cost = \$40 per activity. Indicate your interest on your inquiry form.

Special health & safety precautions: Staff and participants will wear masks throughout the duration of the activity while maintaining a minimum of 6' physical distance outdoors. You elect whether or not another cabin/family will join you. We will not combine you with another group.

### **Guided activities**

**Rare habitats hike** - Learn about the habitats present at Camp Friedenswald, and the way one of them, a prairie fen, hosts the federally endangered Mitchell's satyr butterfly. Discover the part of Camp that is a green paradise all winter long!

**Night hike** - Experience the beauty of the night and some special characteristics about energy and the dark.

**Labyrinths** - Learn a bit about the history of labyrinths and then create your own walkable labyrinth. Enjoy your journey to the center of the labyrinth and back again. Locations and materials for labyrinth creation will vary depending on weather (all locations will be outside).

**Snow painting and sculptures** - Unleash your creativity and have fun building and painting in the snow! Brief instructions, tips, snow paint, and molds for building will be provided. (This activity is dependent on the presence of snow.☺)

**Archery** - Take your aim and have fun practicing the art of archery!

**Fire building** - Discuss fire and energy and learn to build your own fire with flint and steel. Enjoy s'mores cooked over the fire to celebrate!
