



## Healthy Camper Guidelines - COVID-19

In compliance with orders from the State of Michigan, and out of a desire to protect the health of camp staff and guests, we ask you to observe and commit to the following:

- Perform a health check before/during/after camp stay:
  - Stay home if you currently are experiencing, or have experienced, COVID-19 related symptoms in the past 10 days
  - Notify Camp staff if you begin to experience symptoms while at Camp (and be prepared to leave immediately)
  - Notify Camp staff (269-476-9744) if COVID-19 symptoms develop for you or someone in your group up to 10 days after leaving Camp
- Follow social distancing guidelines and maintain at least 6 feet distance from people outside your household
- **Wear a face covering** when interacting with someone from outside your household
- Wash hands with soap and water frequently during your stay
- Abide by scheduled tube run/activity times in order to allow for social distancing
- Communicate your concern of social distancing directly with other guests, if necessary

## Camp Friedenswald Commitment

- Camp staff will observe social distancing when interacting with you and will wear a face covering when interacting with you
- Camp staff will thoroughly clean and disinfect high touch surfaces in your lodging before your arrival
- Shared indoor common spaces will remain closed (i.e. Dining Hall, Game Room, Cottonwood Center, Nature Center)
- Shared outdoor spaces with high touch surfaces will be cleaned daily
- Camp staff will be available (by phone/radio) throughout your stay at Camp to address needs and concerns as they arise. Phones are located at Dining Hall entrance and west side of Dogwood cabin. Pick up the receiver and press the purple button.

## General Guest Guidelines

- Respect other guests and Camp's facilities and grounds by replacing what you moved and cleaning what you dirtied.
- Please be mindful of the 3 R's (reduce, reuse, recycle) to help care for the earth during your stay.
- Please observe an all-camp quiet time of 12:00 midnight.  
After midnight please restrict activities to inside your cabin/lodge.
- Please be aware that cell phone service is unreliable and WiFi is available outside the Dining Hall.
- Alcohol, pets, fireworks, and firearms are not permitted.
- Cigarette smoking is only permitted outside at designated areas where butt containers are located: Nature Center, Lakeview Lodge, and Cottonwood Center
- Bicycles, rollerblades, and skateboards are not permitted on Camp trails or walkways.
- Please adhere to additional policies posted throughout Camp property.

## Winter Activities

- Tube Run – Located near the South cabins, tubes provided. Staff will open when weather conditions allow and close at 10 pm. An adult over 18 must be present. Please follow posted rules.
- Sledding - Located on Bell Hill. Sleds are available in front of the Dining Hall. Please return sleds after use. An adult over 18 must be present.
- Cross Country Skiing – Equipment is available in the Ski Shop located in the Arts and Crafts room off the amphitheater. Follow posted instructions.

## Outdoor Activities

- Frisbee Golf – maps are located outside the Dining Hall lakeside entrance. Frisbees are located in front of the Dining Hall in the cupboard beside the cement grill.
- Tennis – court is located on the upper flat, please **bring your own equipment**.
- Volleyball – sand court is located on the upper flat and a grass court is located on the lower flat.
- Basketball – court is located on the upper flat.
- Soccer – goals are located on the upper flat and the balls are located in front of the Dining Hall in the cupboard beside the cement grill.
